

**ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS
OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE**

Carmel Township, County of Eaton

Ordinance Number 6

An ordinance to affirm an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Carmel located in Eaton County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Township of Carmel ordains:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Director of the Department of Construction Codes for the County of Eaton is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Carmel under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The County of Eaton assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.


Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the Township of Carmel.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled Eaton County, Michigan and dated 11/26/10 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 0300E, 0303E, 0304E, 0311E, 0312E, and 0325E and dated 11/26/10 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

Section 4. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. PUBLICATION. This ordinance duly adopted on November 18, 2010 at a regular meeting of the Township of Carmel shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
